From our modest beginnings, we've grown into a powerful force for change, supporting individuals in need across New Jersey. What started in 1985 as a vision from a group of families seeking permanent supportive housing for their adult children with mental illness, has blossomed into an organization that serves over 1,100 people annually across 10 programs.

"We are proud of how far we've come," says Jenn Stivers, Managing Director of Community Hope. "Mental wellness is the foundation of everything we do, and we're honored to help so many people each year. Our programs provide safe housing, access to critical services, and support for individuals as they work toward independence."

At the heart of our mission is the belief that every person deserves dignity and respect. Through our work in mental health, housing, and veterans' services, we focus on meeting each individual's unique needs. From those living with mental illness to veterans overcoming the challenges of homelessness, we create personalized service plans with each person, ensuring they receive the right level of care and support.


Our veterans' programs not only address the root causes of homelessness, but also provide the tools and support needed to regain independence. "We focus on helping veterans obtain and maintain permanent housing, working with them for up to two years depending on the program," explains Stivers. "For our mental health consumers, some have lived with us for years – even decades. We ensure they have a safe, stable home for as long as they need it, and that they are supported every step of the way."

Community Hope is proud to partner with the Veterans Administration in the SSG Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention Program, providing crucial outreach and services to veterans, active duty service members, and their families. This initiative works to prevent suicide, offering both local and VA-based resources.

From our humble start with just five individuals, Community Hope has become one of the

largest nonprofits in New Jersey, dedicated to helping some of our state's most vulnerable individuals. For 40 years, we've given the gifts of home, stability, and hope to tens of thousands of people.
